

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR “SABANCI FOUNDATION-VISTA SCHOLARSHIP”

GUIDELINES

- Applications must be made directly to the student affairs/scholarship office by the deadline set by the university they are enrolled in. Unless a different deadline is specified by the Student Affairs/Scholarship Office, the applications should be filed at the latest by **October 23, 2020**.
- Sabanci Foundation will not accept any applications directly. Applications sent outside of these dates will not be considered.
- Scholarships given by Sabanci Foundation have no repayment obligation or mandatory employment.
- The maximum scholarship period is 4 years (Not including preparation year).

CRITERIA

Applicants must be:

- A Turkish citizen
- Enrolled in a four year Vocational School in the related faculties of Turkish universities and registered in the department of Tourism Management with required academic reports.
- Applying to a university that has Sabanci Foundation-Vista Scholarship quotas. **See below** for approved universities with required academic reports in the 2020-2021 academic year.

Be registered as full time student. Able to demonstrate financial need. Cannot have any other scholarships (except for those students on state financial credit and on scholarships provided for handicapped students)

EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

The Scholarship Committee of each respective University will review the candidate’s application based on eligibility criteria. Academic success and financial need will be prioritized. The University will notify Sabanci Foundation regarding accepted students.

SCHOLARSHIP ADMINISTRATION

Payments will be only be made to students who complete the registration procedures and whose information regarding academic reports is submitted to Sabanci Foundation at the beginning of each term.

A monthly payment of 780 TL will be transferred to the recipient's bank account for nine months between October and June. The monthly payments are made at the first week of each month.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

Information regarding academic reports and registration procedures must be provided regularly to Sabanci Foundation by the university and be up to date.

Students who successfully continue their education without any condition leading to cancellation of the scholarship or change of department of study (and other criteria as determined by Sabanci Foundation scholarship procedures) can continue for maximum 4 years.
